Lesson 1: The Last Supper

Exploration Stations – coloring, book nook, Easter match, set the table

Bible Story Time – *Matthew 26:17-30, Luke 22:7-38, John 13:1-30* – Jesus sent Peter and John to make the Passover dinner. He gave them directions for where to go and they prepared for the Passover room, just as Jesus had said. That evening, Jesus sat at the table with the 12 disciples. While they were eating, Jesus said, "One of you will betray me." He was talking about Judas. While they were eating, Jesus took bread and gave thanks. Then, he broke the bread and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body." Jesus took a cup and said a prayer of thanks. He gave them the cup saying, "Drink from it, all of you. This is my blood of the new covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins." During the meal, Jesus also got up and began to wash his disciples' feet, showing how to love and serve others. Later, Jesus told his disciples that he would only be with them for a little while, prophesying his death on the cross. He also prophesied that he would be going to Heaven to live with the Father.

Comprehension Questions – 1. What holiday were the disciples preparing for (Passover)? 2. Who was the last supper (Jesus and his 12 disciples)? 3. What did Jesus predict would happen during the supper (Jesus' death and resurrection)? 4. What did Jesus say the bread represented? (his broken body) 5. What did the drink represent? (his blood shed on the cross) 6. How did Jesus show his disciples to love? (by washing their feet)

Prayer Time – Jesus is alive and lives in Heaven to hear our prayers. Who has something we can pray for?

Games/Activities – Serve crackers and grape juice and act out the Lord's supper/communion

Color and Draw – The last supper coloring page

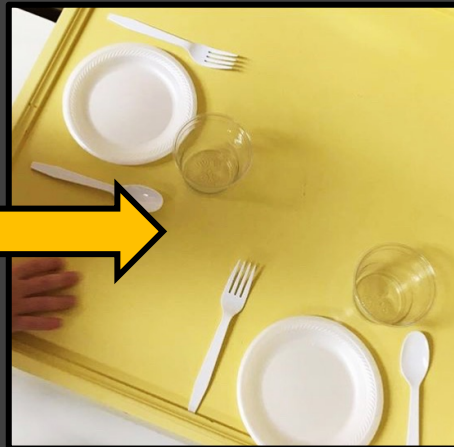

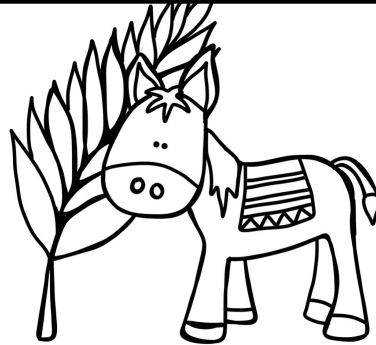

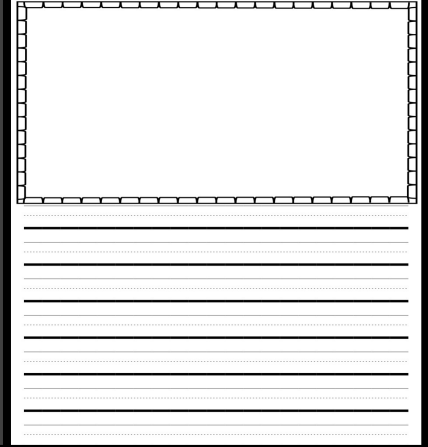

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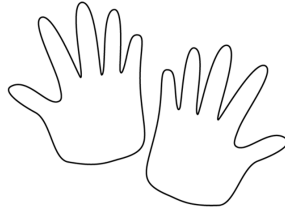

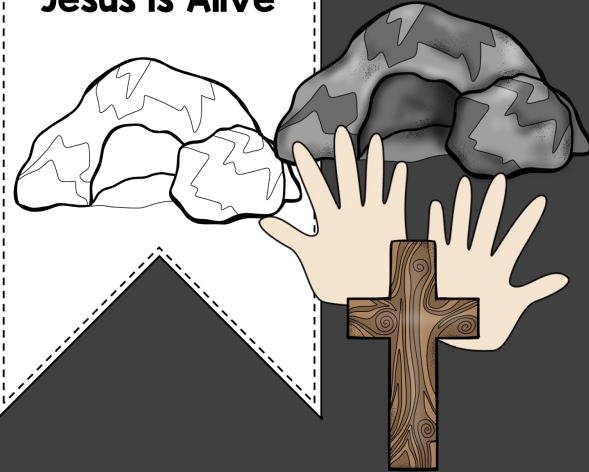
