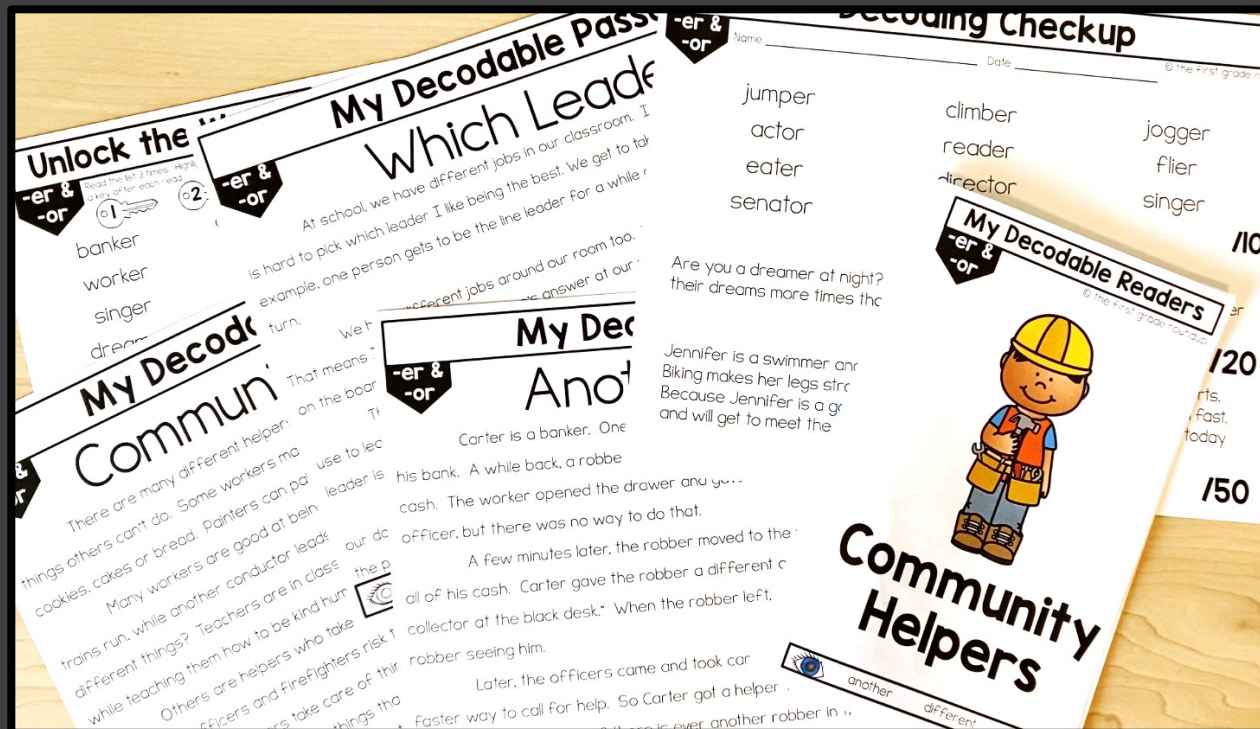

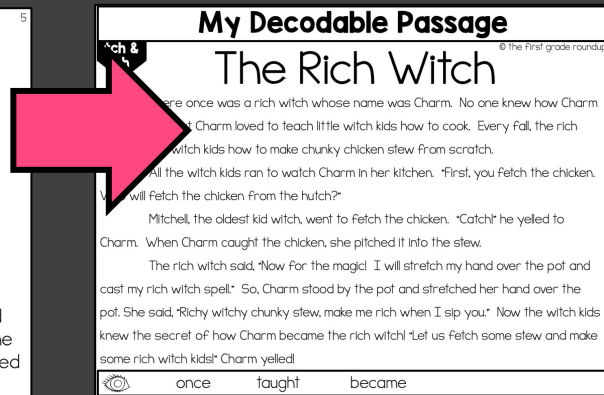
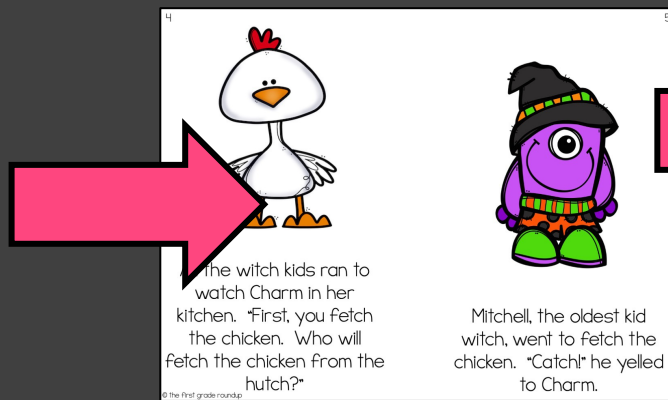

How To Sketch

First, you need to fetch some paper. It does not matter which paper you use. Sometimes I even switch up the kind of paper I use. Next, you need to get a pencil. Get an extra pencil. Catch!

Now we are ready to sketch. We will sketch together. You watch me and try to match my sketch. We will draw a couch. The trick with a sketch is to go fast. Sketch the outline of the couch like this.

Now, we will add a patch on the back of the couch. We will pretend the couch had a scratch from our cat. The patch covers up the scratch! I will add some details like stitch lines on the patch.

The last step of the sketch is to go back over the couch lines to make them stand out. Let me see your sketch. Wow! Your sketch is top notch. Way to go!

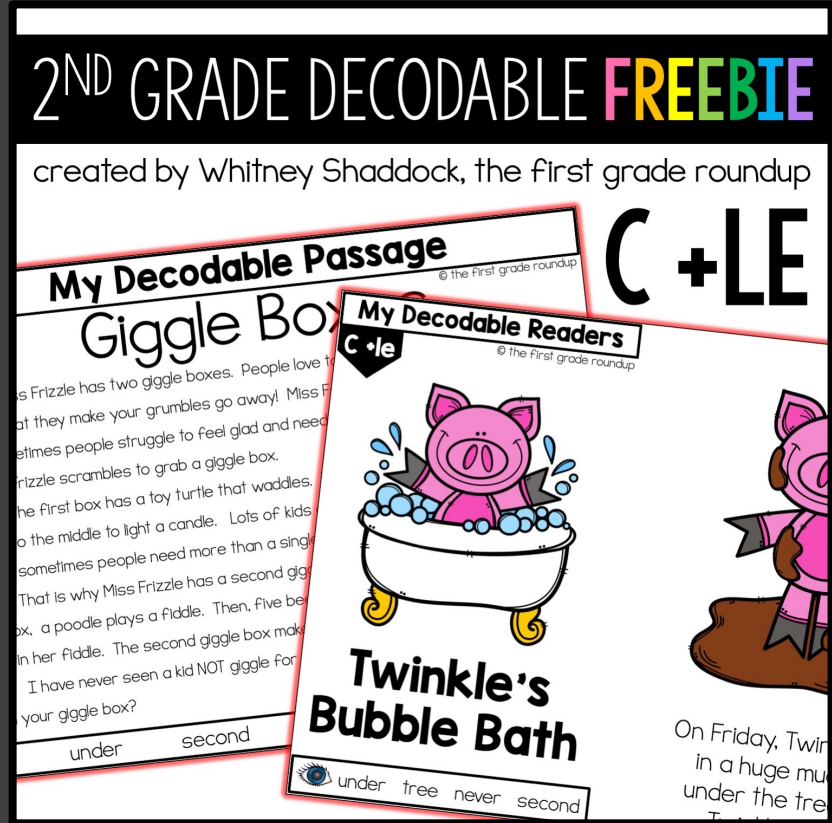

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How To Use Decodables

Research in the science of reading is overwhelmingly supportive of the positive effects of teaching kids to decode. This packet gives you resources to help kids practice decoding in a variety of settings with a specific phonics skill. The skills covered in each decodable resource correlate with my Super Phonics Curriculum: bit.ly/2ndsuperphonics

WHAT'S INCLUDED? One **decodable word list** is included. One **decodable booklet** is included in color, black and white and digital form. Use these to extend your phonics lessons into independent practice. **3 decodable passages** are included to use in small group instruction or intervention. One **assessment** is included for data collection, RTI data, or just weekly check-ups.

Each decodable text includes a few high frequency words. Here's a look at the titles of the texts and their high frequency words.
