UNIT OUTLINE + LESSON SCRIPTS

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Lesson 1: The Lost Sheep

Exploration Stations – coloring, book nook, parable match, lost and found,

Bible Story Time – **Luke 15:1-7** – Sinners (people who had made bad choices) gathered around Jesus to hear him teach. Jesus taught the people a lesson by telling a special story called a parable. A parable is a story that teaches us about God. Listen to Jesus' story and see if you hear the lesson he wanted the people to learn. *Jesus said, "The shepherd has 100 sheep and loses one of them. Wouldn't he leave the 99 sheep in the open field and go after the lost sheep? And when he finds it, he will happily carry the sheep on his shoulder and go home. Then he will tell all of his friends and neighbors and say, 'I'm so excited! I found my lost sheep!'"* Then, Jesus taught that it is even happier in heaven when one sinner repents and asks Jesus in his heart.

Comprehension Questions – 1. Who came to listen to Jesus' parable? (sinners) 2. Who was Jesus' shepherd and his sheep? 3. What did the shepherd do when he lost a sheep? (went to search for it) 4. What was Jesus teaching us with this parable? (he wants all of us to have Jesus in our hearts and not just in our minds)

Prayer Time – Jesus cares about our needs. Who has something we can pray about?

Games/Activities – Play the whole group version of lost and found. Kids close their eyes (or lie down) and have them face the wall-this is what I do while teacher or another kid hides the sheep. Then I will try to find the lost sheep just like Jesus taught us that he looks for people who are lost and don't know it.

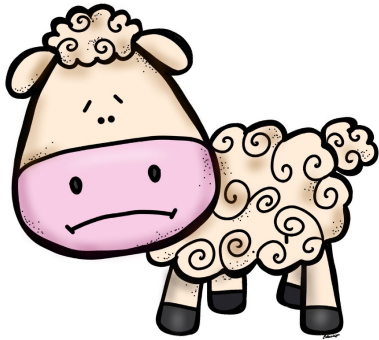

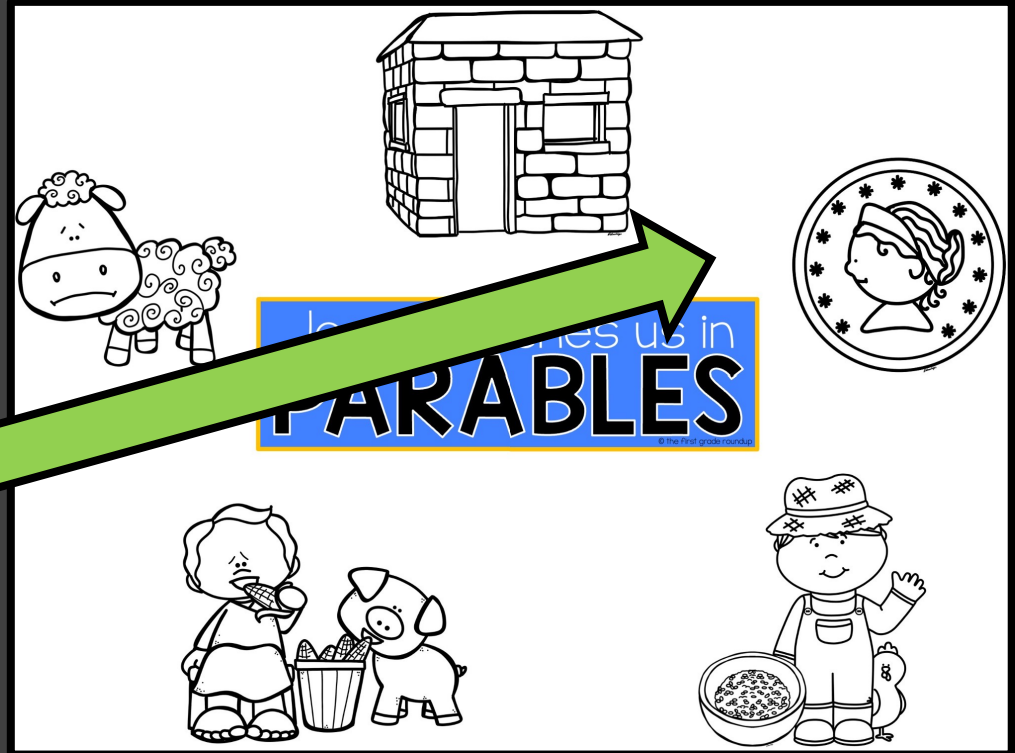
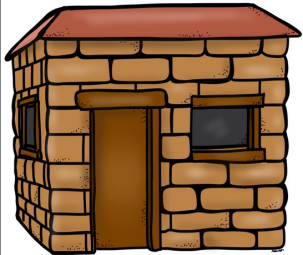
INTERACTIVE UNIT ANCHOR CHART

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Add each piece to the anchor chart as you teach that lesson.

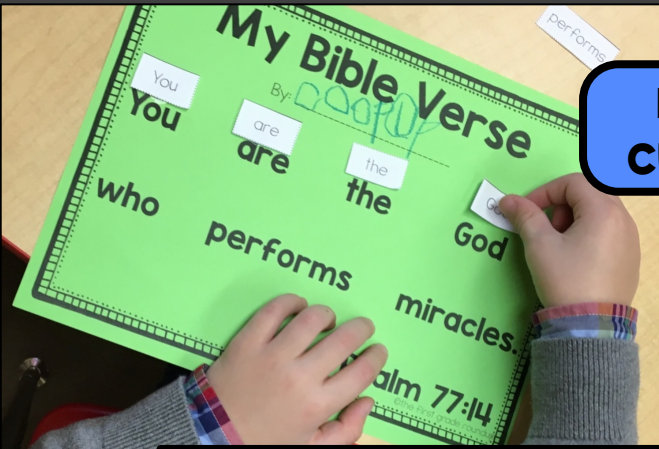
Parables Anchor Chart:

- »Use as a puzzle for an extra exploration station

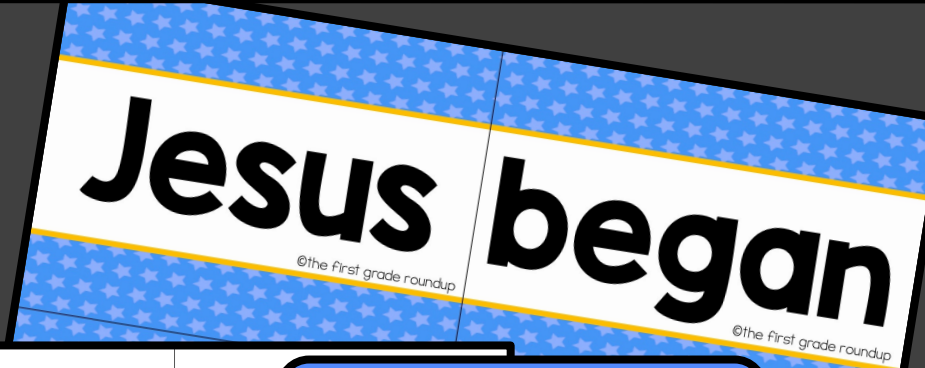
