Floss Your Teeth

Do you floss your teeth? You need to! The dentist will tell you to floss if you want your teeth to be well. I did not know how to floss until my dentist made a fun song about it. Now I can floss well, and I do not miss!

Here is how you floss. First, you pull the strand of floss out of the box. You pull a lot. Just pull a small bit. Press the floss on the end of the box to cut the floss.

Then, twist the floss on your fingers. Pass the floss on each of your teeth. Sometimes the floss will go in with no stress. Sometimes, you will have to pop the floss to fill the crack between the teeth!

After you floss each tooth, toss the floss in the trash. Do not look at the floss. It can be a mess. Sometimes, the floss will have crumbs and stuff on it. Yuck! But your teeth will be less dirty. You do not want an ill tooth. Eek! It may be a mess to floss, but it is worth it to keep your teeth well!

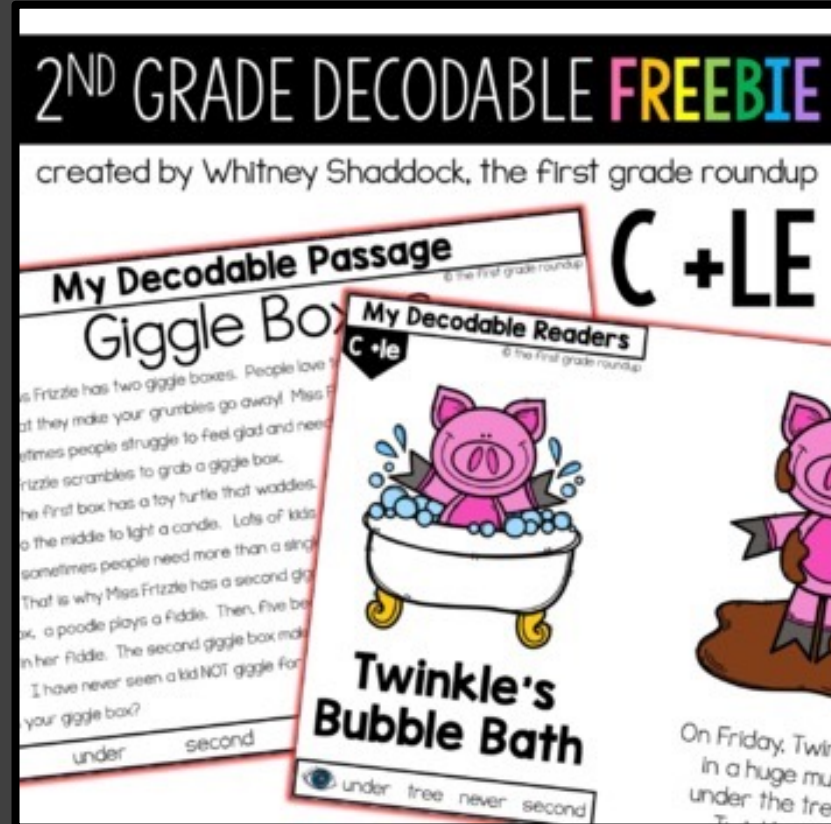

How To Use Decodables

Research in the science of reading is overwhelmingly supportive of the positive effects of teaching kids to decode. This packet gives you resources to help kids practice decoding in a variety of settings with a specific phonics skill. The skills covered in each decodable resource correlate with my Super Phonics Curriculum: bit.ly/2ndsuperphonics

WHAT'S INCLUDED? One **decodable word list** is included. One **decodable booklet** is included in color, black and white and digital form. Use these to extend your phonics lessons into independent practice. **3 decodable passages** are included to use in small group instruction or intervention. One **assessment** is included for data collection, RTI data, or just weekly check-ups.

Each decodable text includes a few high frequency words. Here's a look at the titles of the texts and their high frequency words.

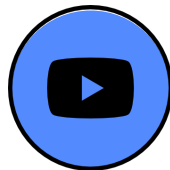

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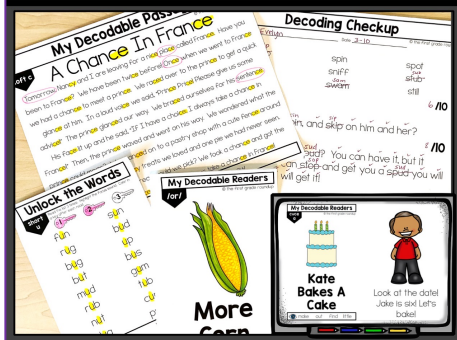

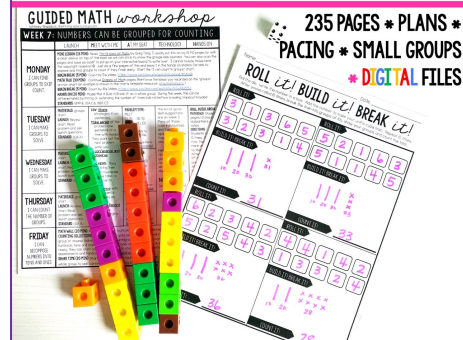
