Research in the science of reading is overwhelmingly supportive of the positive effects of teaching kids to decode. This packet gives you resources to help kids practice decoding in a variety of settings with a specific phonics skill. The skills covered in each decodable resource correlate with my Super Phonics Curriculum: bit.ly/superphonicsbundle

WHAT'S INCLUDED? One **decodable booklet** is included in color, black and white and digital form. Use these to extend your phonics lessons into independent practice. **3 decodable passages** are included to use in small group instruction or intervention. One **assessment** is included for data collection, RTI data, or just weekly check-ups.

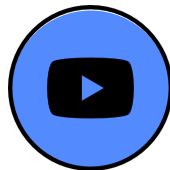

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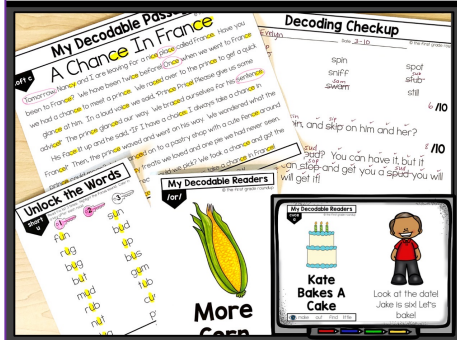

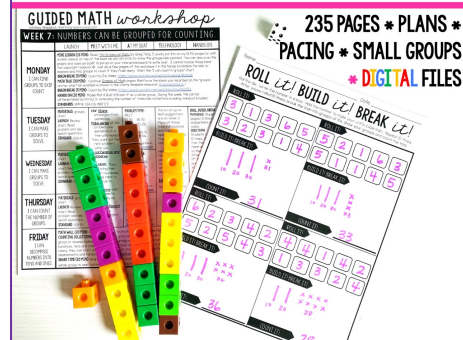
